


Child Care Licensing Rulemaking Process



- Rules may not exceed authority granted through statute.
- Rules are generally written when: 1) Utah statute is new or changed, 2) the Child Care Development Fund (CCDF) issues new requirements and/or 3) there is new research about health and safety standards.
- Approval is granted for public comment to a rule if it does not have a negative impact on the community.
- The public comment period may include public hearings.
- All concerned parties are informed before, during, and after the rulemaking process.
