



1. Prepare

- Gather supplies (clean diaper, wipes, diaper cream, gloves, leak proof bag for soiled clothing, extra clothing) to the diapering area.



2. Clean Child

- Place the child on the diapering surface and unfasten the diaper.
- Clean the child's diaper area. Always wipe front to back.
- Keep soiled diapers and clothing away from surfaces that cannot be easily cleaned. Place soiled clothing in a leak proof bag, labeled with the child's name.



3. Remove Trash

- Discard the soiled diaper and wipes in a trash can with a plastic lining and tight fitting lid, take it outside, or to a trash can that is otherwise inaccessible.
- Remove and discard gloves, if used.



4. Replace Diaper

- Slide a fresh diaper under the child.
- Apply diaper cream, if needed.
- Fasten the diaper and dress the child.



5. Wash Child's Hands

- Use soap and water to wash the child's hands thoroughly.
- Return the child to a safe, supervised area.



6. Clean Up

- Remove liner (if used) from the changing surface and discard.
- Wipe up any visible soil.
- Wet the entire surface with a sanitizing solution. Ensure to read and follow the directions on the sanitizing spray, fluid or wipe.



7. Wash Your Hands

- Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
